Sandra Landy **“Duplicate Bridge as a business”**

What is the Aylesbury Vale Breakfast Briefing?

The Aylesbury Vale Breakfast Briefing will be taking place on the first Wednesday of each month at the Watermead. It provides an excellent opportunity to hear a variety of speakers and network with other local businesses in a relaxed and informal atmosphere.

This month’s topic. Sandra has always been a keen bridge player. She first played for Great Britain in 1967, and played in the women’s world championship, which England won in 1981 and 1985. English women won many other international titles and Sandra led the world rankings for five years. But on January 1st 2000 after 33 years in the women’s team, Sandra decided to call it a day and now only plays at local clubs.

Duplicate Bridge is a competitive form of earlier bridge games which were based on playing socially, usually for money.

The English Bridge Union (EBU) is based in Aylesbury and is the national body for the game. Its headquarters in Broadfields employ about 20 staff, but the Board of Directors consists of unpaid volunteers elected by the shareholders.

Almost every European country has such an organisation, affiliated to the European Bridge League and England is amongst the largest. Most countries in the world belong to the World Bridge Federation. During October, following the Olympic Games, the Mind Sports Olympiad took place in Beijing with an excellent performance from the five English teams, playing in the Open, Women, Senior, Under 21 and Under 28 categories.

During this presentation, Sandra Landy will share her experience of being a world championship bridge player.
